

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR CARNIVAL ENTRY - 2017

1. The Carnival is under the jurisdiction of the Rotary Club of Callington with assistance from Callington Town Council, Callington Lions Club and other organisations. For the purposes of these terms and conditions Callington Rotary Club are the organisers.
2. Carnival vehicles have always been subject to the same road traffic legislation that applies to all road-going vehicles. This includes the minimum requirement for insurance (see Paragraph 10 below). If the vehicle cannot or does not comply with this legislation then a Vehicle Special Order (VSO) may be required.
3. Ensure that the vehicle/tractor and/or trailer are roadworthy and that the driver has received proper training to drive the vehicle and holds an appropriate, valid licence
4. Each float/entry should have a responsible adult nominated as a Supervisor and that adult must provide details required and sign the entry form.
5. **Boarding or dismounting** from the tableaux/float must not take place whilst the vehicle is in motion. Participants should remain seated/static when the tableaux/float is in motion. Where possible construct a firm handrail around the perimeter of the float.
6. Ensure that the tableau is properly and safely constructed with all loose items secured to avoid losing anything on route.
7. **There shall be no throwing of any materials**, liquids or solids from the floats. This includes the throwing or distribution of any advertising material, gifts or samples. 'Giveaways' may be **handed out** to spectators by walkers associated with the float provided there is no action that requires spectators and bystanders to move into or close to the path of any vehicle or trailer. **Collection of monies** on behalf of individuals or individual organisations is strictly prohibited. All monies collected must go into the overall licensed Carnival collection.
8. **Children must be supervised** at all times by responsible adults.
9. **Alcohol must not be consumed by participants before or during the Carnival.**
10. The attached Declaration duly completed, together with written evidence that the Insurers have been notified of the use of the vehicle as a Carnival Float and relevant entry fee must be handed to the Chief Marshal no later than 3.00 p.m. on the day of the Carnival.
11. Control of movement by the Organisers will commence once the Assembly Point is entered. All participants must be in place by 3.15 p.m. as judging will take place at 3.30 p.m.
12. Control of the procession by the Organisers will cease after the vehicles leave the Dispersal Point at the end of the parade. The control of the vehicle and its safety together with that of the passengers will thereafter be solely the responsibility of the Supervisor.
13. The Rotary Club of Callington reserves the right to refuse entry to any vehicle or persons failing to comply with its requirements or conditions whether previously notified or advised at the event. At the event the decision of the Chief Marshal in these matters shall be final.
